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
Who does this apply to:

Diagnosis of Hypertension to be added by GP




Protocol: Home Blood Pressure Monitoring:

Who does this apply to:

- Patients requiring home blood pressure monitoring:
 - Persistently raised readings (see Hypertension diagnosis protocol)
 - Referred by GP / Chronic Disease Nurse- Jackie or Jayne


Patient requires home blood pressure monitoring:

- Send task to Cally or Kay (not artat) who will contact patient and arrange for them to come to treatment room to pick up BP machine (£10 deposit required).
- Patient will be given advice sheet and shown how to use the BP monitor.



Protocol for use of Waiting Room automatic machine

- Who does this apply to?
- Patients who have been invited by text message to have a BP check- either because they already have a hypertension diagnosis and have not had a reading recorded in the past year-**OR** because they do not have a diagnosis and have not had a BP reading in the past 5 years.
- This does not apply to patients who have Diabetes
